















### Afterword

ALEPH UNIT is a serial poem following the principles i had first applied in the ALLEGORIES of eliminating the frame as a compositional unit and thereby compressing what i had spread over a number of frames into one visual unit (thus eliminating linear narrative and moving closer to what i had termed in ANDY spheroid thot) i moved here to make the Aleph shape itself the frame allowing the successive shifts to be dominated by the memory of that frame of reference (ghost image on the retina) the movement was in as opposed to horizontal or vertical moving towards not a conclusion but a piece in which the serial process itself articulated the unarticulated content of the specific sign the titles suggesting what had informed each shift
