## INTRODUCTION

in 1964 i was working at the university of toronto dave was pretty library along with dave aylward sceptical about concrete poetry in those days or anyway the things i was into since at that time we didn't know the term concrete that all came later thank to george bowering introducing me via the mails to cavan mccarthy in england as well as of course andy phillips later trip to france (his letters to me from paris formed the base of ANDY) from which he sent me a few little things actually mentioned the word helped put a name to what at that point dave & i were already into as were in fact bill bissett & judy copithorne & lance farrell & what in his own way earle birney had been into for quite awhile & then of course there was pierre coupey's influential THE ALPHABET OF BLOOD published in dudek's DELTA in december of 64 oh hell i could go on forever giving you that sense that there were purely canadian roots helped anyway in lead us all off in this direction 1965 dave & i decided to start GANGLIA magazine which meant of course that we started GANGLIA PRESS which is what this whole index is here for just to catalogue the activity we've been up to to help us put a fix on our activity in these past 7 years now that grOnk

is wrapping up its old series & GANGLIA is just experiencing a resurgence as a series of postcard poems

we really dug doing GANGLIA for the first two years but then gradually our interest waned there seemed so many mags publishing more or less straight poems & really as far as publishing went we were less & less interested in that — the first series of GANGLIA died a lingering death — the 5th & 7th issues received truly pitiful distribution on our parts — we were discouraged with the whole business of subscribers (who kept (rightfully we had to admit) demanding where their paid for copies were as our publishing schedule regularly fell behind) of poems & the endless stream of self-addressed stamped envelopes in fact of the whole business aspect of it

somehow that wasn't what we were interested in
more fun really were the small pamphlets we did &
ended up giving away to friends that seemed more like
it somewhere in 66 i met dave UU for the first time

he & i & rob (nee rah) smith decided it'd be nice to publish a monthly mag of concrete & related poetries & distribute it free so we invited dave aylward along for the ride launching the first issue of grOnk in january of 67 we ran them thru on a monthly schedule to august of 67 when dave uu moved west & grOnk went under wraps for a year

in september of 68 i started it up again dave uu was still the most active co-editor with bill bissett % steve mccaffery in there in 3rd % 4th we kept churning it out free right up to the present % mailing it out every four to eight months in big chunky envelopes which made for nice gifts of poems for people all 64 issues anyway now times change

the frequency of grOnk as of this date (july 28 1972) is decreasing to make way for other projects GANGLIA PRESS has served its function as a free information service to an audience of about 250 people

its time the bigger more commercial presses started getting the stuff out in bigger better looking more accesible editions of a few thousand its happening & that's heartening dave uu is launching a new mag of his own from his home base in north van

dave aylward's living in japan & translating translating we're all continuing our paths thru the musings glad they converged for this period of time made the whole thing possible
